

Class Rating Instructor

The aim of the CRI training course is to train the candidate to the level of competence defined in FCL.920 and adequate to a CRI. The training course is designed to train applicant adequately in theoretical knowledge instruction, flight instruction and FSTD instruction to instruct for any class or type rating for non-complex non-high performance SP aeroplanes for which the applicant is qualified.
